Synthesis of complex organic molecules with stereochemical aspects. Nanochemistry. Click chemistry. Microwave synthesis. Directed Aldol Reactions. Claisen and Cope rearrangements. Asymmetric epoxidation of allylic alcohols. Catalytic asymmetric dihydroxylation of alkenes. Aminohydroxylation of alkenes. Conformational analysis of complex organic compounds. Synthesis of pharmacologically active organic compounds. Organic Synthesis with Transition Metal Complexes. Domino reactions in organic synthesis. Various chapters in accordance with the PhD thesis.

Synthesis of the selected organic compounds and confirming their structures by spectroscopic methods.
