Syllabus <i>Theoretical instruction</i> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. <i>Spoken language for special purposes.</i> Specific speaking skills necessary for communication in an academic environment, short presentations, discussions and dialogues on professional topics. 2. <i>Written communication for special purposes.</i> Selection and application of content relevant for the profession, including appropriate style, structure and form features (e.g. graphs, reports, CVs) 3. <i>Characteristics of discourse for special purposes.</i> Perceiving differences between general English and English for special purposes, development of reading strategies on major specific texts, description and comparison, numbers and counting, fractions, basic mathematical operations. <i>Practical instruction</i> Practice of communication skills (oral and written) on professional topics, development of reading strategies, grammar comprehension. Interactive approach: discussions, role-plays, individual work, group work, audiovisuals, written and oral assignments.
