Learning objectives Improving language competences, skills and general linguistic knowledge, with a special accent on business register, so that students can independently interpret simple specialized texts, participate in business correspondence and independently write shorter texts.				
Learning outcomes - ability to apply theoretical knowledge in spoken and written form; - ability to successfully translate new texts from German to their native language and vice versa, with or without a dictionary; - knowledge of the most important characteristics, customs and traditions of the nations whose language they study; - systematically learn the most common expressions and phrases in order to become able to recognize various language registers and norms of communication – technical terminology.				
Syllabus <i>Theoretical instruction</i> Each teaching unit includes the treatment of the text (pronunciation, vocabulary, phraseology) as well as the introduction and explanation of the corresponding grammar form: Angaben zur Person (Verb im Präsens), Familie, Tagesablauf (Possessivpronomen, trennbare Verben), Essen und Trinken (Artikel, Präpositionen) Soziale Beziehungen (Modalverben), Wohnen (Präp. mit Dativ und Akk.), Reisen und Verkehr (Futur, Imperativ), Beruf und Arbeit (Perfekt), Einkaufen und Wegbeschreibung (Personal- und Reflexivpronomen). <i>Practical instruction</i> Practical exercises, which follow the theory, are aimed at practicing, repeating and verification of the knowledge, skills and habits. Theory and practice are closely connected in teaching the foreign language.
