Learning objectives Improving language competences, skills and general linguistic knowledge, with a special accent on business register, so that students can independently interpret simple specialized texts, participate in business correspondence and independently write shorter texts.				
Learning outcomes Students should: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - be able to apply theoretical knowledge in spoken and written form; - be able to successfully translate an unknown text from German to their native language and vice versa, with or without using of dictionary; - know the most important characteristics, customs and traditions of the nations whose language they study; - systematically learn the most common expressions and phrases in order to become able to recognize various language registers and norms of communication – technical terminology. 				
Syllabus <i>Theoretical instruction</i> Each teaching unit includes the treatment of the text (pronunciation, vocabulary, phraseology) as well as the introduction and explanation of the corresponding grammar form: Stadt und Land (Kausalsätze), Gesundheit und Krankheit (Pronominaladverbien) Arbeitsplatz und Karriere (Vorgangspassiv), Geschäftsbrief (Finalsätze), Postsendungen (Adjektivdeklinationen), Fachbereich Augenoptik/Optometrie (Konditionalsätze, Konjunktiv, Infinitivkonstruktionen). <i>Practical instruction</i> The translation of professional texts is aimed at practicing, repeating and verification of the knowledge, skills and habits. Theory and practice closely connected in teaching the foreign language.
