<b>Syllabus</b> <i>Theoretical instruction</i> Cognitive psychology and perception. Senses – definition and classification. Sensation and percept. Vision and visual system. Eye movements. Perception of colour, luminance and lightness; phenomenon and theories of colour perception. Perception of edges, objects and faces. Perception of space and depth.  <i>Practical instruction</i> Includes exercises and student seminars.
