## Learning objectives

## **Syllabus**

Theoretical instruction

To learn literature search and writing of literature review (definition of structure, reference list). Topic choice is related to influence of environment on health (water, air, soil or waste). Thematic choice is given by the lecturer and they are related to different pollutants of organic or inorganic origin, radioactivity, regulations etc. Team work training, creating of meeting reports related to literature repositories and division of tasks among the group. Preparation of presentation and presentation in front of the group.

*Practical instruction*-consultations related to topic selected. Internet search and library search. Abstract writing and definition of key words. Writing of seminar. Creation of presentation and its defence.
