Learning outcomes:

Expanding knowledge about physical, geographic and social characteristics of Vojvodina

Syllabus

Fieldwork I is aimed at expanding students' knowledge about geographic characteristics of Vojvodina.

First day: students will be introduced to natural and social values of the region of Bačka. Visit to Karadjordjevo, horse breeding museum, stable, racetrack and hunting ground. Franciscans monastery, remains of the Turkish bath and the Bačka fortress are visited near Bač. Travelling to Odžaci, Srpski Miletić, Bogojevo, Sonta (VEINDL MOR castle and part of the nature reserve Gornje Podunavlje), Svilojevo and Junaković spa. Visiting the spa. Travelling to Apatin and Sombor. Sightseeing (Cathedral, former city hall of Bač-Bodroška county). Visiting the gallery of Milan Konjović. Second day: sports centre "Krivaja", Bačka Topola and "Zobnatica" stable. Subotica and Palić Lake, its physical and social characteristics sightseeing. Visiting "Rokin salaš", on the coast of the Ludoško lake. Kanjiža spa sightseeing. Travelling to Senta, Čoka ad Mokrin to Kikinda. Kikinda sightseeing, mammoth fossils in Kurija, the National Museum, City Hall, Saint Nicola's Church. Visiting Novi Bečej and the dam on the Tisa river. Third day: visiting Rusanda spa. Zrenjanin sightseeing, city hall, the National Theatre, Serbian orthodox church, the Roman Catholic church and Reformation Church, Court hall, the National Museum. Visiting "Ečka" castle and Carska Bara swamp. Travelling by boat on the Begej river. Travelling to Belo Blato. Visiting ethno yard (ethno class). Travelling to Kovačica. Visiting the Gallery of Naive Arts. Travelling to Alibunar, Vršac and Mesić. Mesić monastery sightseeing. Visiting Vršačka tower. Fourth day: travelling to Bela Crkva. Visiting the Belocrkvanska lakes. Travelling to Banatska Palanka, Stara Palanka (estuary of the Nera into the Danube, ending of the Danube-Tisa-Danube canal). Travelling to Kovin, Pančevo, Belgrade, Šimanovci, Pećinci (Jeremija – the Serbian Museum of Bread) and Kupinovo. Visiting Obedska bara swamp. Eco-class about special nature reserve. Travelling to Dobrinci, Kraljevci, Ruma and Vrdnik. Visiting the thermal spa and the Ravanica monastery. Travelling to Zmejvac and Novi Sad.

Fieldwork I is aimed at expanding students' knowledge about physical, geographic and social characteristics of Bačka, Banat and Srem regions.
