Learning objectives

Comprehension of language skills needed for the profession, obtaining successful level of written and oral communication in English and basics for further training in profession.

Learning outcomes

Syllabus

Theoretical instruction

- 1. Spoken language for specific purposes: vocabulary building strategies, specific academic terminology in geography and similar disciplines; presentations
- 2. Written communication for specific purposes: academic writing, converting graphic information into text; describing tables; maps and diagrams; paraphrasing, writing a CV, Letter of Motivation.
- 3. Specific discourse features: word formation, prefixes, suffixes, passive and infinitive constructions, complex sentences and sentence connectors, articles, abbreviations.

Practical instruction

Communication skills, reading for specific information; skimming/scanning techniques; grammar practice, understanding the meaning of certain expressions; listening comprehension; basic research strategies on the Internet and in academic texts.
