Regional geographic areas of Asia and Africa, and the regional geographic parts of all their countries, with a special insight into physical-geographic and socio-geographic characteristics. <i>Practical instruction</i> Practical application of study units presented in thematic charts and diagrams by filling out the Practice Forms created for this course. Elaboration of written assessments with topics strictly connected to regional analysis, as well as to regions and countries of the continents of Asia and Africa.
