Syllabus

Theoretical instruction:

Within the realization of the fieldwork with fourth year students, preparatory classes will be made, where students will be introduced to the itinerary and their activities and tasks in the field. Upon completion of the preparation, teachers and students access the implementation of the fieldwork.

Practical instruction:

Carrying out fieldwork in the area of western Serbia, eastern Bosnia and Herzegovina and Montenegro. Fieldwork is done according to the following curriculum: journey through the Fruška Gora group, Ruma, Sremska Mitrovica, Kuzmin, Sremska Rača, Bijeljina, Zvornik (break), Vlasenica, Han-pijesak, Sokolac, Rogatica to Višegrad (tour of the bridge on the Drina). The journey continues through Goražde and Foča to Tjentište (Tour of the memorial and the National Park "Sutjeska"). The journey continues through Gacko and Bileća to Trebinje (hotel accommodation, dinner, bed). After breakfast tour of the historic center of Trebinje and the Gračanica Church, then continuing the journey to Herceg Novi (tour of the old town), and then across the Bay of Boka Risan and Perast to Kotor (tour of the old city). The journey continues to Budva (hotel accommodation, dinner, bed). After breakfast departure to Cetinje (visit the Museum of King Nikola, Billiard and Treasury Cetinie Monastery). The journey continues across the Rijeka Crnojevića, Virpazar, tunnel Sozina, Sutomore over to Bar (Old Bar tour). Back through Sutomore, Petrovac and Bečići, Budva (old city tour, return to hotel, dinner). Departure after breakfast. Journey through Cetinje, Podgorica, the Morača canyon to the Morača monastery (tour). The journey continues through Mojkovac to Žabljak (Visit the administration of NP "Durmitor", go to the Black Lake, hotel accommodation, dinner, bed). Morning departure to the Savin kuk in Durmitor, and then continue to the bridge Đuđevića Tara (tour). The trip continues across the road to Pljevlja and Prijepolje to the monastery of Mileševa (tour), and then to the Ethno-Eco Village "Vraneš" (tour). Continue traveling through Nova Varoš, Užice, Požega, Kosjerić, Valjevo, Koceljeva, Šabac and Ruma to Novi Sad.
