Course title: Fieldwork 5

Requirements: None				
Learning objectives Introduce students to the geographic area, or natural geographic and social processes that have been taking place. Students are introduced to the way of research, analysis and reasoning of certain geographic parameters of the study field.				
Learning outcomes Students learn to properly and professionally study natural and social factors in the geographic space and to apply the knowledge obtained. To use the course specific literature during the fieldwork.				
Syllabus <i>Theoretical instruction</i> <i>Practical instruction</i> First day: A journey through Zagreb, Novo Mesto and Ljubljana (the main morphological features and functional structure of the city, morphological and urban ecology changes). Visit to the Geographic Institute "Anton Melik", SAZU. The trip to Bled and Kranj over Lešica. Observing the impact of economic changes in the region. Second day: Tour of Bled (old town, elements of glacial erosion and accumulation; Visit to the High school of catering), Bohinj lake, waterfall and Savica (hydrologic characteristics). Drive to Jesenica and Kranjska Gora, Soca and Bovec valley (morphological forms on Triglav, the hydrologic characteristics of the river Soča, characteristics of tourism of Bovec). Return over Log, Trbiš and Sava Dolinka fount to Bled. Third day: Departure to the Postojna cave (cave morphology), and continue the journey through Kranj and Ljubljana and Vrhnika. Travel through Koper and Izola to Portorož and Piran (characteristics of tourism in the Slovenian coast, intense urbanization). Return via Trst (tour) and Nova Gorica (cross-border cooperation of the bordering regions) to Bled. Fourth day: Departure to Velenje (tour of the Museum of Mining, urban ecology of the town) and the Logar Valley (glacial form, glacial trough). Drive to Maribor and Rogaska Slatina. Accommodation in the hotel. Fifth day: Introduction to the Rogaska offer (presentation). Private farm visits (Perkovič) - tasting of local products. The journey continues through the Krapina (Museum of Evolution and the site of primitive man - Hušnjakovo).
