Expected outcomes:

Production of the original scientific work whose results should provide a certain contribution to further detailed and more serious research of the given scientific discipline or geographical area.

Enabling a graduated master student to work as a Geography subject teacher in primary and secondary education sector, and work in educational-scientific institutions.

General contents:

Graduation master thesis is a research work, which introduces students to a research methodology in the field of Geography. After conducting research, students prepare the Master thesis, which contains the following chapters: Introduction, Theoretical part, Experimental part, Results and Discussion, Conclusion, Literature overview.

Topics and content of graduation-master theses within a Master Professor of geography study programme, could comprise various scientific fields and disciplines:

- Methods of teaching Geography
- Physical Geography
- Human Geography
- Regional Geography

Methods:

Obligatory oral defence of Master graduation thesis in front of the officially summoned and approved evaluation board.
