Learning objectives To gain theoretical knowledge and practical expertise in training for self-assessment of all kinds of game trophies from our hunting grounds.				
Learning outcomes After passing the exam from both the course and the Commission for the hunting trophies from Hunting Association of Serbia, students receive a degree in the trophy evaluation, according to the existing Laws on Hunting (Fig. gl. RS no. 18/10 from March 26, 2010), and the Regulations on the program and rules for takings exams for evaluation of game trophies and the Regulations on Appraisal of game trophies.				
Syllabus <u><i>Theoretical instruction</i></u> History of hunting trophies evaluation and development of assessment models for big game trophies and the taxidermy of fowl game, keeping records of hunting trophies of the big game, filling out the forms (based on the Law on Hunting) for the trophy and grade lists, the importance of necessary aids in the process of evaluation of trophies, literature essential for the evaluation of trophies, practical evaluation of large game hunting trophies, how to process hunting trophies, measurement techniques for big game trophies (deer, fallow deer, roe deer, mouflon, wild boar, chamois and wild goat) and skulls (wolves, jackals, wild cats, foxes, badger, bear, lynx and enok) and furs from wolves, jackals, lynxes, wild cats and bears. Introduction to the best trophies from home and abroad, the criteria for awarding medals for all species evaluated, the role and importance of hunting trophies in hunting tourism and review of products made from discarded antlers. <u><i>Practical instruction</i></u> Practice, Other forms of teaching participation in the Fair of Hunting, Fishing, Sport and Tourism in Novi Sad, in assessment of trophies, as well as the development concept for the exhibition of trophies, setting up exhibits and labelling them. Didactic and practical assessment of the trophies displayed on the LORIST fair (International Fair of Hunting, Fishing and Sport). Research is done in theoretical and practical classes. Students are trained to competently and independently evaluate the trophies of the big game that are bred in our hunting grounds.
