Coastal, mountain and city tourism. Cultural tourism. M.I.C.E. (business) tourism. Nautical tourism. Transit tourism. Rural tourism. Eco-tourism. Spa, health and wellness. Sports and recreational tourism. Hunting. Religious Tourism. Ethno-culinary and wine tourism. Extreme forms of tourism. Alternative forms of tourism. Postmodern tourism as a global simulacrum. <i>Practical instruction</i> Cooperation with institutions and organizations in tourism and hospitality industry - conducting research in the topic, and critically assessment of the phenomenon; proposing optimal solutions to certain specific forms of tourism.
