Learning objectives

Syllabus

Theoretical part:

Demographic development of nations and nationalities of Vojvodina. The number and the structure of the population. Serbs, Hungarians, Croats, Bunjevci, Sokci, Slovakians, Montenegrins, Romanians, Roma, Rusyns, Ukrainians and others.

Costumes, customs, song, dance, culinary characteristics of people in the Balkans, in Europe, Africa, America, Asia and Australia. Resorts, languages, food, clothing, types of economic activity, customs and specifics analyzed by continents.

Practical part:

Getting to know the specific folklore heritage of the peoples living in Vojvodina and Serbia in general (folk architecture, museums, galleries and ethnological, material, spiritual and technical culture). Reports on the data collected on the ground in the form of seminar.
