Persons with disabilities and students of Roma nationality, who have been enrolled and completed basic studies as students funded from the budget of the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina, may be enrolled in the first year of master academic study programs funded by the Autonomous Province of Vojvodina at the University of Novi Sad and the faculties within it where they completed those studies, in the school year 2025/2026, by applying affirmative measures for enrolment in studies of persons with disabilities and members of the Roma national minority.

2. Admission criteria:

Candidates eligible to register for enrolment competition for master studies are those:

- who have obtained the VII-1 degree of professional qualification, and achieved, after the recognition of passed exams, a minimum of 180 (for study programmes: mathematics and informatics), or 240 ECTS (for all other study programmes);
- who have completed three-year or four-year basic academic studies (according to the Law on Higher Education), and achieved, after the recognition of passed exams, a minimum of 180 ECTS (for study programmes of mathematics and informatics), or 240 ECTS (for all other study programmes).

3. Entrance exam:

Enrolment criteria for master studies are different for five Departments of the Faculty of Sciences. Ranking of candidates and entrance modules have been defined in **The Rulebook on Enrolment of Students in Study Programmes of the Faculty of Sciences in Novi Sad** (https://www.pmf.uns.ac.rs/wp-content/uploads/2026/05/Pravilnik-o-upisu-studenata_eng-2026.pdf).

4. Application periods:

First Application Period:

Candidate applications: September 23 – October 6, 2026

Preliminary ranking list: by October 12, 2026

Final ranking list publication: October 14, 2026

Enrollment of budget-funded students: October 15–16, 2026 (according to the schedule published on the Faculty website)

Enrollment of self-financing students: October 19, 2026

Second Application Period:

Candidate applications: October 22–23, 2026

Preliminary ranking list: by October 28, 2026

Final ranking list publication: by October 30, 2026

Student enrollment: November 2, 2026 (budget-funded), November 3, 2026 (self-financing)

Third Application Period:

Candidate applications: November 5, 2026

Preliminary ranking list: November 9, 2026

Final ranking list publication: November 12, 2026

Student enrollment: November 13, 2026

Note: The second and the third enrolment competition will be organised only for the study programmes at which there are vacancies after the first competition period.

5. Documents to be submitted for registration of candidates:

1. Application form
2. Original documents for inspection
3. Photocopy of diploma or certificate of obtained diploma
4. Transcript of passed exams (candidates who did not obtain their diploma at the Faculty of Sciences in Novi Sad must also submit curricula and syllabi of their completed previous-level studies)
5. Scanned ID card (if it has a chip) or a copy of the ID card
6. Proof of payment of application fee
7. Certificate/nostrification for candidates undergoing document recognition
8. A member of the Serbian national minority from a neighboring country, when submitting the application and required documentation for enrollment, must also submit a written statement declaring their membership in the Serbian national minority. The higher education institution publishes a model statement on its website.
9. Statement for candidates who completed master academic studies before the 2025/26 academic year regarding whether they studied under budget funding.

Candidates eligible for **enrolment** submit the following:

1. original documents from items 1. and 2. of this article (submitted upon registration);
2. two photos 4,5 x 3,5 cm;
3. proof of payment for enrolment expenses and student collective insurance premium.
4. proof of payment for self-funded students,
5. enrolment pack (student's booklet, enrolment document) – it is obtained exclusively at the faculty's bookshop (with the proof of payment for enrolment expenses and insurance);
6. ŠV form is completed online, after the enrolment.

Note: Candidates who studied at previous levels as state-funded students shall not have the right to re-enrol at the same level of studies as state-funded students.

6. Fees:

- **for registration: 2000,00 Serbian Dinars (RSD);**
- **for material costs of the enrolment and insurance: 7500,00 Serbian Dinars (RSD).**

7. Criteria for the final ranking of candidates:

The ranking of the candidates on the final ranking list is based on:

- the length of the period of studying at the previous levels of study (four-year or three-year studies);
- average grades at the previous levels of studies;
- ECTS credits equivalence at the previous levels of studies;
- special requirements defined by The Rulebook on Enrolment of Students in Study Programmes of the Faculty of Sciences in Novi Sad (https://www.pmf.uns.ac.rs/wp-content/uploads/2026/05/Pravilnik-o-upisu-studenata_eng-2026.pdf).

Note: When compiling the ranking list of candidates applying for enrollment, candidates who are enrolling in studies at that level and at that higher education institution for the first time are ranked first, followed by the ranking of other candidates (Article 100, Paragraph 15 of the Law on Higher Education).

8. Individual complaint procedures and deadlines for the final ranking list:

A candidate may submit an appeal regarding the regularity of the procedure established by the admission contest, or concerning their position on the ranking list, within 36 hours from the publication of the preliminary ranking list on the Faculty's website.

The appeal shall be submitted to the Dean through the Department Commission, based on whose reasoned proposal the Dean issues a decision on the appeal within 24 hours from the moment of receiving the appeal. The candidate submits the appeal to the Faculty's Student Services Office.

The ranking list of candidates shall be considered final if no appeal has been submitted.

9. Enrolment of international students:

International students enrol in master academic studies under the same criteria as the students who have citizenship of the Republic of Serbia, based on the verified documents.

A special requirement for international students' enrolment in master academic studies is proficiency in the Serbian language. International candidates are required to submit a certificate of Serbian language proficiency.

Additional documents are submitted during the candidate registration.

International candidates – foreign citizens, at the registration for the Competition submit a recognized diploma (or certificates of diplomas submitted for recognition) of completed secondary school and the academic level equivalent to the basic academic studies.

Prior to the enrolment – foreign citizens are obliged to submit to the faculty:

- Diploma recognition document;
- Certificate of health insurance for the academic year to be enrolled at;
- Certificate of Serbian language proficiency (Language proficiency is tested at the Faculty of Philosophy, Centre for Serbian as a Foreign Language).

10. Note:

Protective clothes are obligatory for working in the laboratory.

Fieldwork and practical student training are compulsory for all students and constituent parts of educational process. Fieldwork and practical student training expenses are covered by the students regardless of their status (state-funded, self-funded).

Upon completion of the enrolment, candidates who failed to enrol should collect their documents from the faculty no later than December 5, 2026. After that period the documents will not be available.
